The scientific committee will receive the abstract without authors and affiliation information.

The selection process will be communicated not later than June 15<sup>th</sup> 2017.

The winner will be selected after the committee evaluation of the speaker performance during the meeting. In order to receive the award the winner must attend the meeting dinner of September  $8^{th}$ .
