

Peter Gloviczki, MD, FACS, is the Editor-In-Chief of the Journal of Vascular Surgery Publications. He is the Joe M. and Ruth Roberts Emeritus Professor of Surgery at Mayo Clinic, Rochester, Minnesota, USA, previously served as Division Chair and Director of Gonda Vascular Center. A 1972 graduate of Semmelweis University in Budapest, Hungary (sub auspiciis rei publicae popularis), he did residencies and fellowships in general and vascular surgery in Budapest, Paris and in Rochester, Minnesota, at Mayo Clinic. He joined the staff of Mayo Clinic in 1987. He authored 450 peer-reviewed publications, edited eight textbooks, Google Scholar lists 32,555 of his citations with an h-index of 98. Dr Gloviczki mentored 85 vascular surgery fellows and 25 research fellows. He was President of the Society for Vascular Surgery (SVS), the World Federation of Vascular Societies, American Venous Forum (AVF), the International Union of Angiology and the Society for Clinical Vascular Surgery, among others. He is Fellow of the American College of Surgeons, member of the American Surgical Association, Distinguished Fellow of the SVS and the AVF. He received Honorary Membership in 19 national and international societies. He received the Medal of the City of Paris, was named Advisory Professor of the Jiao Tong University in Shanghai and the International Angiology Curatorium recognized him with the Max Ratschow Medal. The Semmelweis University awarded him the “Doctor Honoris Causa” degree, the American Hungarian Foundation the George Washington Award. The University of Washington, Seattle, established the Peter Gloviczki Professorship in Venous and Lymphatic Disorders. He was awarded the Officer’s Cross of the Order of Merit of the Republic of Hungary. Dr Gloviczki’s hobby is magic, he received national and international awards. He is married to Dr. Monika Lecomte Gloviczki.
