SUBJECT: Food for Veins – Veins for Food 2020 report

From **June 7** to **Aug 30, 2020**, world renowned experts from all the continents gather together every Sunday from 2 to 3.30 pm GMT, developing not for profit educational webinars dedicated to venouslymphatic disease.

The project name is **Food for Veins – Veins for Food**.

"FOOD for VEINS" indicates the will of providing "food for thoughts" about how to manage venous and lymphatic disease at best. The mission is crucial considering venous disease can lead to thrombo-embolism, "leading cause of preventable death" (Lancet Haemat 2015;2(10):393), while lymphatic impairment is still so underdiagnosed and poorly managed to be defined as a "hidden epidemic" (World Health Organization, Wound & Lymphedema Management, 2010).

"VEINS for FOOD" indicates the will of delivering this educational experience for free, suggesting free donations in support of FOOD POVERTY PROJECTS, particularly in a covid pandemic post-lockdown economic crisis that is "redefining the vulnerability" in many populations (Lancet 2020;395(10230):1089).
