- Word count: 300 words in BACKGROUND, METHODS, RESULTS, DISCUSSION format.
- Tables & figures equal to 25 words each. Figure legends are included in the word count.
- Abstracts already presented and/or published elsewhere are accepted.
- References must be included (Vancouver reference style).
- References don't affect the word count.
