Deep Insights in Vein-lymphatic Education

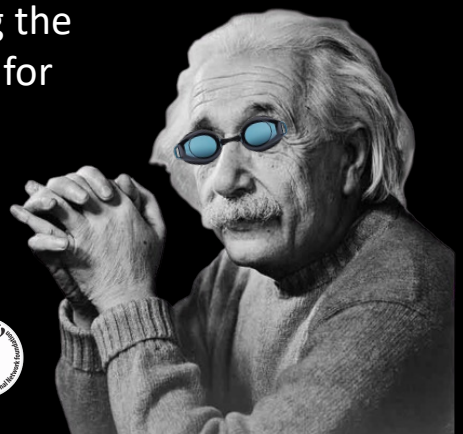
