





Primary endpoint of v-ITALY 2023 project is to gather together top Experts from all continents and top professionals from different sectors to analyse the met and unmet needs in Vein & Lymphatic practice, reaching out to the global community of Vein & Lymphatic health professionals, as well as to the patients, identifying the "**VITAL**" **steps forward** for a proper advancement of Vein & Lymphatic care.
